- Listing of specific expenses to be covered by scholarship for the following. **Winter Season:** ski pass, Allegro Program fee, competition fees, equipment. **Summer Season:** Allegro Program fee only.
- Copy of the first page of the parents' most recent IRS Form 1040. If the immediate past year's IRS return has not been completed, please also supply some form of confirmation of the immediate past year's income (Example: W-2).
- Statement of financial hardship, if applicable (e.g. special needs in family, # of children in college, illness, etc.)
